The closing date is Wednesday, January 2, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at the Trial Secretary's address after which time entries can not be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6, of the Dog Show Rules and Chapter 1, Section 20-21 of the regulations for Agility Trials.

RUNNING ORDER

Running Order sheets will be emailed to exhibitors with final confirmation. Exhibitors who wish to have a copy at the trial should print their own copy and bring it to the trial.

### WAIT LIST

After the closing date of Wednesday, January 2, the DSA is offering a wait list to fill openings created by entries withdrawn after closing. A maximum of 20 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the trial secretary prior to Wednesday January 2 at, 6:00 PM. Any entries withdrawn prior to Monday, January 14, 6:00 PM will be replaced by a wait listed entry when available. A full refund will be given for withdrawn entries when a wait listed entry is available to replace the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, January 14 will have entry form and method of payment shredded. If partial entries move in a refund will be issued for entries that did not move in.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age and older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word 'dog' is used in these regulations it includes both sexes. Canine Partners are allowed entry into this set of trials.

### HANDLER WALK-THROUGH, TIMING AND WARM UP

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog. Electronic timing devices may be used.

### MOVE UPS

Move-Up entries for Saturday, January 19 and Sunday, January 20 will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date January 2 at 6:00:00 PM. MST. Email notification of move ups is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6:00 PM, Monday January 14. Move-up entries for Sunday, January 20 must be delivered to the Trial Secretary, within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging on Saturday, January 19.at the trial site.

### MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms. **Telephone, Telegraph, and Unsigned Entries** cannot be accepted. Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. Funds. Payment must accompany entry. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

All entry forms and payment checks that do not make the draw for the trial or do not move in to the trial will be shredded after the closing date unless otherwise requested.

**Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

**This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.**

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with, and are able to perform, all of the obstacles safely.

**ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES** except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), guest(s), and children.

Any exhibitor whose dog(s), guest(s), and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made. Parents are solely responsible for their children, and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety. No baby strollers in the show buildings.

**UNENTERED DOGS MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOW SITE.**

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not permitted at the trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season before these trials take place will be refunded provided the Trial Secretary receives notice from a veterinarian in writing prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial. A \$10.00/day entered recording fee will be withheld for entries withdrawn due to a bitch being reported in season.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, violent acts of nature, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crate.

No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site.

**Please respect the grounds and clean up after yourself and your dogs!**

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions: The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class." After the close of entries a dog may be moved down in their class level (ie, Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
